Traditional Dress Code

The Uniform Dress Code does not allow for clothing with colored trim, stripes, embroidery, decoration, etc. It also does not provide for overalls (overalls with pants or shorts), sweat pants, knit pants/skirts, leggings, etc.

Bottoms:

- Navy, khaki/tan, black or jean
- Shorts, pants, skorts, skirts, skirted jumpers
- Must be plain, solid-color twill, corduroy or denim fabric;
- **NO holes or cut offs allowed**
- No Overalls, **sweat pants**, or knit pants/skirts

Tops:

- White, red or navy **with collar**
- must have long or short sleeves
- polo-type or woven dress shirts, blouses or turtlenecks
- School t-shirts are the only t-shirts permitted (available thru the school office)

Other dress code rules

- **a belt is required if the garment has belt loops**
- shirts (including t-shirts) must be tucked in
- shorts/skirts must be mid-thigh or longer
- **MANDATORY** closed toed shoes with rubber soles. Sandals and open-toed shoes **ARE NOT** permitted

Behavior Marking System

Throughout the course of the school day, students are recognized for positive behavior. Some teachers prefer to use colors, other teachers use numbers.

- All students start on white/0
- Students earn colors/numbers throughout the day when they make good choices. Red/1, orange/2, yellow/3, green/4, blue/5, purple/6.
