English Language Arts

Our learning target for September is to use collaborative conversations to ask and answer questions using sequence about key details in a text. Some questions you can ask your child: What happened first, next, and last in the story? Who are the characters? What is the setting? Please practice sight words and read 30 minutes every day.

Math

In Math, the learning target is to add and subtract to solve word problems. We are learning about equal equations. Students will use pictures and manipulatives to add and subtract. We have started SMAD testing of basic addition and subtraction facts so please practice every night.

Writing

Students will use key detail graphic organizers to help comprehend the text. They will practice using sentence frames to retell key details in the text.
