<p>In ELA we have had a very busy year already. We have learned about the different types of text structures and are beginning to understand how and why the author used the text structure. We are continuing to work on using context clues to help us determine the meaning of unknown words and phrases. We wrap up the month with main idea and key details.</p> <p>Keep reading at home! Mrs. Taylor has added new incentives and special brag tags for the year. Let's earn those points!</p>	<p>In Math students have just finished learning and testing on the Module 1 content: recognizing number value and place value, different forms of writing a number, comparing numbers, rounding, adding and subtracting numbers. In Module 2 contents students will be learning about multiplication number relationships, find missing numbers in an equation, list factors and multiples of numbers, multiply multi-digit numbers using various strategies, and calculate area and perimeter of shapes. Students should be studying their multiplication, division, addition, and subtraction math facts every night.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Our writing is progressing. We are learning about the writing process and how to increase our writing stamina. The District Writing Assessment is coming up soon. We look forward to seeing what our students are capable of doing.</p>	<p>In Science students have been learning lab safety and procedures. They have been learning the difference between experiments and investigations and how to use their five senses and the scientific method when making observations and inferences.
