Reading

Students are working on a literature standard for character's actions and traits. They should be able to retell what happened in a story and how a character can influence what happens next in the story. They will also be determining the main idea of a text using key details to support that idea.

Math

Students have reached our fractions unit. Though some may seem to struggle with these concepts you can help! Start small with thinks around the house like cutting sandwiches or pizza into equal parts and talk about the fraction for 1 of those parts. Also measuring cups and items that come in cartons and packages are a good way to represent equivalent fractions. **Ex. In a carton of a dozen eggs, 6 eggs can be 6/12 or 1/2 of the carton.**

Writing

Students continue working on writing complete sentences, using grammar and punctuation correctly, and completing paragraphs to help construct an essay.

Science/Social Studies

Students are starting a Unit on heat and light energy. They will observe, discuss, and investigate the transfer of energy. They will also learn about ways heat is produced, measured, or changed. Real life application: have students practice reading a thermometer and checking the weather for predicted temperatures. Make observations about temperature differences certain times of day or in various locations such as shade or direct sunlight.
